## BIPARTISAN CONCERNS OF VOTING MACHINES

- Then Senator Kamala Harris: “I brought in folks who, before our eyes, hacked into voting machines.”
- Florida Representative Val Demings: hackers “with limited prior knowledge, tools and resources are able to breach voting machines in a matter of minutes.”
- California Representative Lieu: “they just need to hack a few counties in one swing state” to overturn an election.

## THINK ABOUT THIS...

- EVERY computer is hackable!
- Internet communication is not secure!
- Hacked E-Pollbooks can CHANGE whether a voter voted yet or not.
- Paper ballots are the only way to prevent hacking!

# NO ONE ENSURES MACHINE SECURITY

- The FL Auditor General evaluated the Election process and found repetitive and highly sensitive cyber security issues.

- States have a unit that does certification of machines, but certification does ZERO REVIEW OF CYBERSECURITY.
- Federal government DOES NOT regulate election equipment – changes must be made at the State level.

# ANYBODY CAN VOTE IN FLORIDA

- One SOE (Supervisor of Elections) and his ‘attorney’ said THERE IS NO SUCH THING AS A LEGAL FLORIDA RESIDENT. This is incorrect. [Article VI, Florida Constitution.](#)
- One SOE said they don’t verify anyone’s registration address; they “just take their word for it.” It could be a Walmart, a post office box or a vacant lot.
- Supervisors of Elections (SOE):
  - Allow voters to make up addresses
  - Are not following statutory requirements to maintain voter rolls
  - They are not protecting our elections system

# ACTIVE VOTER VS INACTIVE VOTER

- There are voters who haven't voted since 2006 who are still considered active on our voter rolls. Something isn't right here...are they active or inactive?
- An inactive voter remains eligible to vote until he or she is removed from the official list of registered voters by the SOEs.
- NO voters are removed from the rolls during the 90-day window before a federal election.

# WHY WORRY ABOUT ADDRESSES?

- If an active voter moves out of state, they should be removed from the rolls immediately. If not, the new resident could receive and vote in previous resident's name!
- If your credit card company mailed your NEW card to an OLD address, would you worry?
- Unethical people can make up voter registrations – get paid for them – and the SOE “just takes their word for it.”

A LIBRARY CARD is harder to get!



# ONLINE VOTER REGISTRATION

**Florida statute 97.0525 (4)(C) Online voter registration**  
allows:

- (4) The following persons are **exempt** from the identification requirements of this section:
  - **(a) Persons 65 years of age or older.**
  - (b) Persons with a **temporary** or permanent physical disability

# DOMINOES OF FRAUD

- SOEs said they DO NOT verify the legitimacy of addresses, even though Florida statutes require them to check

AND

- Many SOEs mailed a “vote by mail request form” to every voter in the county, even though the voter is REQUIRED TO REQUEST this form.

THE RESULT?

- Vote by Mail requests were sent to addresses that were not residential and/or were not where the voter actually lived.

BAD VOTER ROLLS = BAD VOTES



# ARE SOEs DOING THEIR JOBS?

- Voting machines/systems are highly technical – is your SOE or their staff capable of monitoring the technical vendors?
- Voting Machine vendors control signature verification settings – this is when your signature is matched by the machine to the signature on file.
- Who sets the signature sensitivity level on these machines? Our SOE claimed he didn't know the setting level used in 2020. Does yours?
- If they are doing their job, how are voters voting from campgrounds, UPS boxes, vacant lots and the cemetery? FL statutes require SOEs to check those addresses for validity.

# LIFELOCK WATCHES \$\$; WHO WATCHES VOTES?

- Is your SOE better at cybersecurity than the DHS (Dept of Homeland Security)? The State Dept, parts of the Pentagon, parts of the US Treasury, SolarWinds, and the CDC, were affected by cyber attacks in 2020 – NY Times Dec 14, 2020

- You have fraud alerts for unusual purchases, multi-factor verification for online transactions. You show ID to make a withdrawal in person at your bank. You have to show ID to get your tickets to sporting events or concerts.

You have NO IDEA if someone votes in your name or with your address unless you look in the voter rolls – and you can **never** see who you voted for.

# DO YOU KNOW YOUR ADDRESS?

- Florida Statutes and the Voter Registration form states you must use your complete residential address, and IF YOU DON'T, your registration is incomplete.
- Where did you have your stimulus check sent? A storage unit?
- Would the ambulance be able to find you without an apartment number?

Would a **legitimate** voter register at a fake or incomplete address?

# CANVASSER STORIES

While canvassing nursing homes I provided the administrator with a list of voters registered at their facility. At every nursing facility, the staff told me there were people on my list they did not know or were deceased. There were also inactive voters who should have been removed from the rolls, per Florida statute, because they haven't voted in two federal elections. – by June

We canvassed a family with six registered voters. According to the SOE database, the previous owner voted by mail in the 2020 election! The current family of 5 purchased the home in 2016. The owner told us they all stood in line for hours to vote. We told her that the SOE database indicated both she and her husband did not vote. “We stood in line for hours and our vote didn't count?” Needless to say, she was not a happy camper! - by Sue

After viewing her voting history in The People's Audit, a woman was shocked to see her vote from 2012 listed as Vote by Mail when she has never voted by mail in her life. She was also listed as voting in the 2020 primary when she knows she has never voted in a primary election. Has the manipulation of our votes has been going on for much longer than we thought? - by Diane

# WHAT NEEDS TO BE DONE?

The Secretary of State and ALL SOEs need to follow the law and conduct their due diligence –

1. ONLY US CITIZENS WHO ARE LEGAL FLORIDA RESIDENTS cast votes in Florida elections. [Article VI, Florida Constitution](#). Voters rolls must be strictly maintained.
2. RETURN TO PAPER BALLOTS! Why do we have machines if most voters don't want them?
3. PROTECT OUR ELDERLY VOTES! Facilities must be open to bipartisan participation and assistance for our most vulnerable citizens.
4. GET RID OF ERIC!

# WHAT IS ERIC?

- The [Electronic Registration Information Center \(ERIC\)](#) is a non-profit organization that claims to improve the accuracy and access of America's voter rolls.
- 30 of 50 States used ERIC in 2020.
- ERIC reports:
  1. Voters who have moved within or out of state
  2. Voters who have died
  3. Duplicate registrations in the same state
  4. Potentially eligible new voters

Does Florida allow ERIC to make the changes without input from the state officials. We are still trying to get an answer to this question.

# WHO IS BEHIND ERIC?

- ERIC began as a [Pew Charitable Trust](#) project and was seeded with funding from the MacArthur Foundation, the Joyce Foundation, and [George Soros' Open Society Foundation](#).
- Chuck Hagel had been owner and Chairman of ES&S, whose computerized voting machines *would soon count his own votes!* Hagel stepped down from his post just two weeks before announcing his candidacy for Nebraska US Senator. Yet he retained millions of dollars of stock in ES&S.

You may remember him as the Nebraska Republican Senator (1997 – 2009) that later became Obama's Secretary of Defense (2013).

## WHAT IS AN NPA?

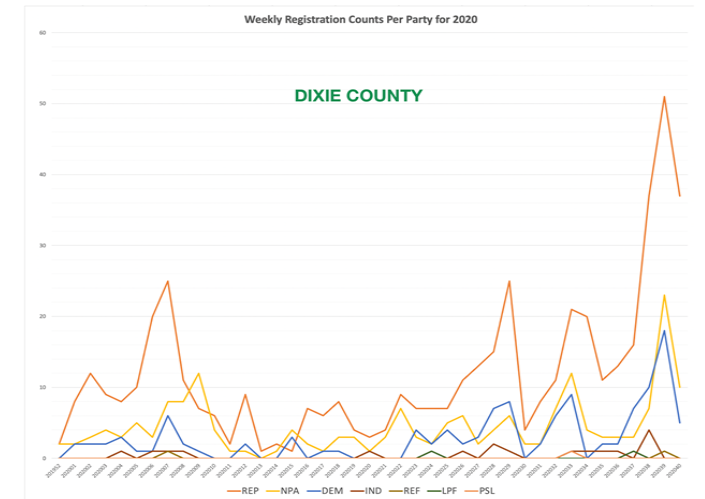
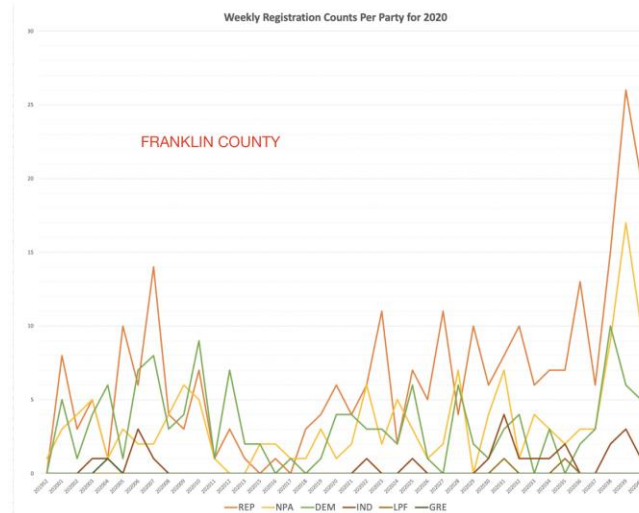
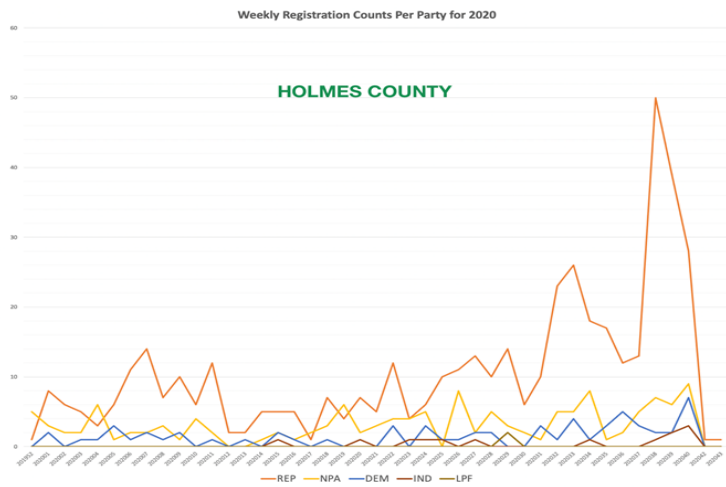
It is a common misconception that "NPA's" (Non-Party Affiliate) are not eligible to vote in Primary Elections.

"NPA's" are eligible to vote in Primary Elections when any of the following entries appear on the Primary Ballot:

- Universal Primary (all candidates for an office have the same party affiliation and the winner will have no opposition in the General Election – e.g., write-in candidate)
- Any nonpartisan contests – (e.g., local school board contests)
- Any State Constitution or local referendums that appear on the Primary Ballot

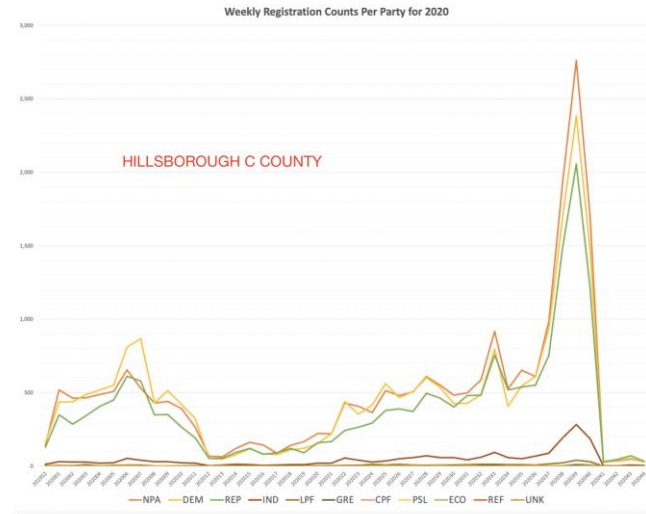
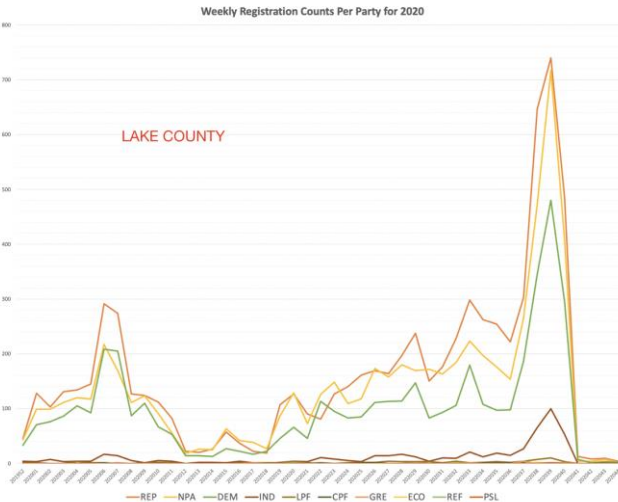
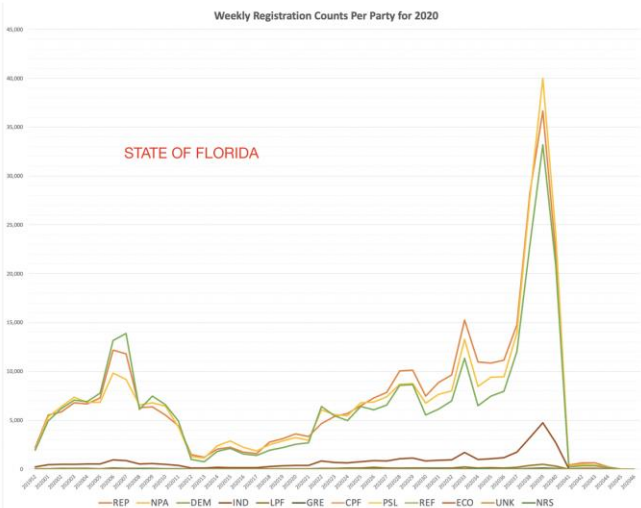


# RANDOMLY OCCURRING REGISTRATIONS

## LOUISIANA TO SUSPEND PARTICIPATION IN VOTER REGISTRATION COMPACT

**BATON ROUGE, La.** — Secretary of State Kyle Ardoin has announced that Louisiana will suspend its participation in the Electronic Registration Information Center (ERIC), effective immediately. The announcement comes amid concerns raised by citizens, government watchdog organizations and media reports about potential questionable funding sources and that possibly partisan actors may have access to ERIC network data for political purposes, potentially undermining voter confidence.

“When Louisiana joined ERIC under my predecessor, we did so under the impression that it would enhance the accuracy of our voter rolls and strengthen Louisiana’s election integrity. After reading about these allegations and speaking with election attorneys and experts, I have determined that it may no longer be in Louisiana’s best interests to participate in this organization,” Secretary Ardoin said. “It is vital that any legitimate allegation of voter fraud or possible misuse of our voters’ personal information is investigated. My job is to ensure that the data voters entrust to my office is protected. I look forward to ERIC’s swift response to these allegations.”

ERIC was founded in 2012 by seven states, including Colorado, Delaware, Maryland, Nevada, Utah, Virginia, Washington and the Pew Charitable Trusts. It has since grown to include 30 states and the District of Columbia. Louisiana joined the organization in 2014.

# FLORIDA VOTER'S BILL OF RIGHTS

## Voter's Bill of Rights

Each registered voter in this state has the right to:

1. Vote and have his or her vote accurately counted.
2. Cast a vote if he or she is in line at the official closing of the polls in that county.
3. Ask for a replacement ballot if he or she makes a mistake prior to the ballot being cast.
4. Receive up to two replacement ballots if he or she makes a mistake prior to the ballot being cast.
5. An explanation if his or her registration or identity is in question.
6. If his or her registration or identity is in question, cast a provisional ballot.
7. Written instructions to use when voting, and, upon request, oral instructions in voting from elections officers.
8. Vote free from coercion or intimidation by elections officers or any other person.
9. Vote on a voting system that is in working condition and that will allow votes to be accurately cast.

# CALL TO ACTION

- Call your Representatives and Senators to let them know you don't want voting machines KNOWN for security failures and corrupt practices. Back to PAPER BALLOTS!
- Call Governor DeSantis and Secretary of State Lee and DEMAND they get rid of ERIC. The Governor could fire ERIC today!
- Volunteer to be a poll worker or poll watcher. Sign up TODAY and take the training through your SOE office.
